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Why is Disclosure information important?



Disclosure information empowers electricity customers

...

by providing them with trustworthy information on the sources of their electricity

But in most countries, the electricity mix is still much more *non-GO*-guaranteed than it is GO-guaranteed!

- **Reliable disclosure of electricity from renewable sources is *not* a problem => thanks to **EECS GOs!****
- **Problem is reliable disclosure of electricity from *other* sources!**
- **RE-DISS stepped up to the challenge and provided guidance and the residual mix calculation**
This has improved the accuracy of disclosure information significantly!
- **As disclosure is reason why GOs are issued, AIB sees it as essential to expand it's focus and also cover disclosure regulations**

So the AIB needs to step up for customers



- The AIB sees the EAM/RM as a cornerstone of reliable and trustworthy disclosure information
- ... and therefore of great value to Europe's electricity customers
- As the end of RE-DISS was announced, AIB saw the EAM/**RM** as too important for Europe's electricity customers to not take action

The AIB will take over 2 of the 4 tasks currently executed by the RE-DISS II project

4 Tasks being taken up by RE-DISS II



- **Task 1: Calculation of Residual Mix / European Attribute Mix**
- Task 2: Maintenance of Best Practice Recommendations
- Task 3: Hosting workshops to exchange experiences between Competent Bodies for GOs and disclosure
- **Task 4: Provision of relevant information for decisions on the recognition of foreign GOs / regular update of country profiles**

**AIB decided to take over tasks 1 and 4, which are
operational tasks**

Task 1 and task 4 taken over by AIB



Task 1

- Executed with the help of a consultant (contract with AIB)
- Publication of the first AIB RM/EAM in May 2016

Task 4

- Publication of changes to country specific information on the AIB website as soon as they occur (special focus on GO implementation, disclosure practices and recognition)

Tasks 2 and 3 are more policy oriented and would ideally be picked up by other organisation(s)

Could this be a task for the Council of European Energy Regulators (CEER)?

- CEER has recognised the value of reliable disclosure information in the [Advice on customer information on sources of electricity](#)
- Most competent bodies are either regulators or being regulated
- CA-RES could provide guidance to CEER...

The AIB and the future of Disclosure

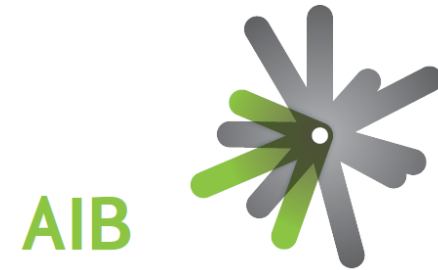


Our goal: better disclosure information that **empowers** the electricity customer
